EXERCISING TWO TWO-YEAR OPTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE LEASE OF THE BERNARDSVILLE RAILROAD STATION FROM NJ TRANSIT

WHEREAS, New Jersey Transit Corporation ("NJ Transit") is the owner of the Bernardsville Railroad Station parcel, which is located on Mine Brook Road, and known as Block 144, Lot 1 on the Borough tax maps; and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit and the Borough of Bernardsville (the "Borough") entered into a Lease Agreement (hereinafter, "Lease") on November 7, 2006, for the lease to The Borough of portions of a station parcel situated on Block 144, Lot 1 on the Official Tax Map of the Borough of Bernardsville, also known as the Bernardsville Railroad Station.

WHEREAS, NJ Transit and The Borough entered into a Lease Amendment Agreement on May 13, 2015, which, inter alia, extended the Term of the Lease to December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, NJ Transit and The Borough entered into a Second Lease Amendment, dated December 27, 2022, which provided for a revised expiration date of December 31, 2030, and included two (2) additional option terms of two (2) years each (through December 31, 2034);

WHEREAS, Bernardsville Borough wishes to exercise its options so that the lease with NJ Transit will extend through December 31, 2034;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Borough of Bernardsville does hereby exercise the two two-year options to extend the lease of the Bernardsville Railroad Station through December 31, 2034.

Transit.
