MAKING DETACHED ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS A PERMITTED ACCESSORY USE IN THE R-1 AND R-1-10 ZONES AND SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING ARTICLE 12 OF THE BOROUGH LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS ENTITLED "ZONING"

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Board in its Resolution #2023-14 finding that

Ordinance No. 2023-1974 is not inconsistent with the master plan went on to recommend that

"the Borough Council consider, from a policy perspective, whether it desires to continue treating
detached accessory dwelling units as conditional uses, which requires Planning Board
application even for fully conforming conditional uses, or alternatively to designate same as
permitted accessory uses, which would only require a land use board application in the event of
some other relief being necessitated by the development project"; and

WHEREAS, the governing body has determined that detached accessory dwelling units should be a permitted accessory use in the R-1 and R-1-10 zones;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that Article 12 of the Borough Land Regulations entitled "Zoning" are hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section LD-12-5.1 entitled "Permitted Primary Use [in the R-1 Residence District] is hereby amended as follows:

§ LD-12-5 R-1 RESIDENCE DISTRICT. § LD-12-5.1 Primary Intended Use.

This zone district is designed for single family residential use but permits:

f. <u>Accessory Dwelling Units, Detached.</u>

Accessory Dwelling Unit, Detached. Accessory dwelling units created pursuant to

this section shall comply with the provisions of the New Jersey Uniform
Construction Code (N.J.A.C. 5:23). For purposes of this section, "living area" shall mean all rooms and enclosed floor space within a dwelling unit used or designed to be used for living, sleeping, cooking or eating purposes, including bathrooms, laundries, pantries, foyers, communicating corridors, closets and storage space, excluding unfinished basements, garages, unfinished storage areas and other unfinished areas. The following conditions shall be met:

- 1. A detached accessory dwelling unit shall only be permitted on lots containing at least double the minimum area required by Subsection 12-5.3g.
- 2. There shall be no more than one principal residence and one detached accessory dwelling unit on any one property.
- 3. The detached accessory dwelling unit shall not be occupied by more than four persons.
- 4. The living area of a newly constructed or converted detached accessory dwelling unit shall not exceed 1,500 square feet.
- 5. A newly constructed accessory dwelling unit or proposed conversion of an existing building to an accessory dwelling unit must meet the setback requirements of a principal building.
- 6. No lot containing a principal residence and a detached accessory dwelling unit shall be subdivided unless each resulting lot with its improvements complies in all respects with the requirements of this section and the requirements of the R-1 Residence District.
- 9. Prior to issuance of a building permit for the detached accessory dwelling unit, a new deed shall be recorded in the Somerset County Clerk's Office containing a restriction stating that the detached accessory dwelling unit must be used in strict compliance with this section.

This zone district is designed for single family residential use but permits any use as permitted and regulated in R-1 Residence District, except for detached accessory dwelling units, including conditional uses pursuant to § 12-25 limited to the following:

§ LD-12-6.2 Prohibited Uses.

Any use other than those permitted in Subsection **12-5.1 12-6.1** *is prohibited.*

Section 4. Section LD-12-22.1 entitled "Permitted Primary Uses [in the R-1-10

Residence District] is hereby amended as follows:

§ LD-12-22 R-1-10 RESIDENCE DISTRICT. § LD-12-22.1 Primary Intended Uses.

This zone district is designed for single family residential use but permits:

f. Accessory Dwelling Units, Detached.

Accessory Dwelling Unit, Detached. Accessory dwelling units created pursuant to this section shall comply with the provisions of the New Jersey Uniform

Construction Code (N.J.A.C. 5:23). For purposes of this section, "living area" shall mean all rooms and enclosed floor space within a dwelling unit used or designed to be used for living, sleeping, cooking or eating purposes, including bathrooms, laundries, pantries, foyers, communicating corridors, closets and storage space, excluding unfinished basements, garages, unfinished storage areas and other unfinished areas. - 2. There shall be no more than one principal residence and one detached accessory dwelling unit on any one property.

- 4. The living area of a newly constructed or converted detached accessory dwelling unit shall not exceed 1,500 square feet.
- 5. A newly constructed accessory dwelling unit or proposed conversion of an existing building to an accessory dwelling unit must meet the setback requirements of a principal building.
- 6. No lot containing a principal residence and a detached accessory dwelling unit shall be subdivided unless each resulting lot with its improvements complies in all respects with the requirements of this section and the requirements of the R-1 Residence District.
- 9. Prior to issuance of a building permit for the detached accessory dwelling unit, a new deed shall be recorded in the Somerset County Clerk's Office containing a restriction stating that the detached accessory dwelling unit must be used in strict compliance with this section.
- <u>f-g.</u> Other accessory uses customarily incident to the above uses provided they do not include any activity commonly conducted for gain unless specifically permitted in this Article.
- <u>g.h.</u> Conditional Uses pursuant to § 12-25, limited to the following:

Section 5. Paragraph "m" of is hereby repealed:

§ LD-12-25.2 Conditional Uses Permitted.

m. [Reserved]

Accessory Dwelling Unit, Detached. Accessory dwelling units created pursuant to this chapter shall comply with the provisions of the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code (N.J.A.C. 5:23). For purposes of this section, "living area" shall mean all rooms and enclosed floor space within a dwelling unit used or

designed to be used for living, sleeping, cooking or eating purposes, including bathrooms, laundries, pantries, foyers, communicating corridors, closets and storage space, excluding unfinished basements, garages, unfinished storage areas and other unfinished areas. The following conditions shall be met:

- 1. A detached accessory dwelling unit shall only be permitted in the R-1 and R-1-10 Residence Districts on lots containing at least double the minimum area required by Subsections 12-5.3g and 12-22.3g.
- 2. There shall be no more than one principal residence and one detached accessory dwelling unit on any one property.
- 3. The detached accessory dwelling unit shall be for the sole use of the on-site domestic employees, members of the immediate family or nonpaying short-term guests of the resident of the principal residence, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program. In any event, the detached accessory dwelling unit shall not be occupied by more than four persons.
- 4. The living area of a newly constructed or converted detached accessory dwelling unit shall not exceed 1,500 square feet.
- 5. A newly constructed accessory dwelling unit or proposed conversion of an existing building to an accessory dwelling unit must meet the setback requirements of a principal building.
- 6. The dwelling structure shall comply with the Uniform Construction Code and Uniform Fire Code Requirements to the extent required by the Construction Official.
- 7. No lot containing a principal residence and a detached accessory dwelling unit shall be subdivided unless each resulting lot with its improvements complies in all respects with the requirements of this section and the requirements of the R-1 Residence District or R-1-10 District.
- 8. The applicant shall submit at the time of seeking conditional use approval, and annually thereafter, a certification on forms provided by the Borough, as follows:
- (a) That the detached accessory dwelling unit is occupied by on-site domestic employees of the residents of the principal residence or by members of the immediate family or short-term, nonpaying guest of the residents of the principal residence, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program. In any

event, the detached accessory dwelling unit shall be occupied by no more than four persons.

- (b) That the detached accessory dwelling unit is not a rental unit and no rent is paid on account of the occupancy of the accessory apartment, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program.
- (c) That the living area of the detached dwelling unit is not a rental unit and no rent is paid on account of the occupancy of the accessory apartment, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program.
- (d) That upon any violation of this section or the certification, determined by the appropriate Borough official, the violation shall be abated and the owner shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Article 16 of this Code.
- 9. Prior to issuance of a building permit for the detached accessory dwelling unit, a new deed shall be recorded in the Somerset County Clerk's Office containing a restriction stating that the detached accessory dwelling unit must be used in strict compliance with this section.

Section 6. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 7. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 8. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE 23-1987

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING CONSTRUCTION CODE FEES AND AMENDING CHAPTER 12 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "BUILDING AND HOUSING"

WHEREAS, the DCA Uniform Constriction Code regulations provide in N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.17 that "the municipality shall set enforcing agency fees by ordinance "; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.17 further provides that:

('b) On or before February 10 of each year . . . the construction official shall, with the advice of the subcode officials and in consultation with the municipal finance officer, prepare and submit to the governing body a report detailing the receipts and expenditures of the enforcing agency and indicating his recommendations for a fee schedule, based on the operating expense of the agency"; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.17 also states that "the fee schedule shall be calculated to reasonably cover the municipal costs of enforcing the regulations"; and

WHEREAS, Borough Construction Official Chris Diacik submitted a report on Jine 6, 2023, in which he made his recommendations, in accordance with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.17 (b), for a fee schedule based on the operating expenses of the agency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville, in the County of Somerset, New Jersey that subsection 12-1.2 entitled "Fees" in section 12-1 entitled "State Uniform Construction Code" in Chapter XII of the Borough Code entitled "Building and Housing" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 12-1.2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 12-1.2 Fees.

The fee for a construction permit shall be the sum of the subcode fees listed in paragraphs a through g paid prior to the issuance of a permit. 20% of the construction permit fee shall be considered as the plan review fee, which will be collected at the time the permit is issued and is nonrefundable.

- a. Building Subcode Fees. The building subcode fees shall be as follows:
- 1. Fees for new construction shall be based upon the volume of the structure. This fee shall be in the amount of \$0.05 per cubic foot, except structures on farms \$0.0007. The minimum fee shall be \$65 \$80 for a single trade.
- Fees for renovations, alterations, reroofing, repairs, and site construction associated with pre-engineered systems of commercial farm buildings, premanufactured construction, and the external utility connections for premanufactured construction, shall be based upon the estimated costs of the work.

This fee shall be:

\$24 per \$1,000 of estimated cost of work up to \$100,000 of estimated cost of construction;

\$18 per \$1,000 for estimated cost of work above \$100,000;

\$10 per \$1,000 for additional costs over \$150,000 estimated cost of construction. The minimum fee shall be \$80 \$45 for a single trade.

- 3. Fees for additions shall be computed on the same basis as for new construction (volume) for the added portion.
- 4. Fees for combination renovations and additions shall be computed as the sum of the fees computed separately in accordance with paragraphs 2 and 3 above.
- 5. Temporary structures and all structures for which volume cannot be computed, such as swimming pools and open structural towers, shall be charged a flat rate. The fee for construction or installation of a single-family residential in-ground swimming pool shall be \$200 \$150. The fee for construction or installation of all other use groups inground swimming pools shall be \$200. The fee for aboveground pools shall be \$100. The fee for fences shall be \$45.
- 6. The fee for the construction or installation of tennis courts shall be \$150.
- 7. The fee for mechanical permit for R-3 and R-4 structures shall be \$45.

- d. Fire Subcode Fees. Fire subcode fees shall be as follows:
- 1. The fee for sprinkler systems shall be \$60 for up to 20 heads;

For 21 to and including 100 heads the fee shall be \$120;

For 101 to and including 200 heads the fee shall be \$2 per head;

For 201 to and including 400 heads the fee shall be \$2 per head;

For 401 to and including 1,000 heads the fee shall be \$2 per head; and

For 1001 heads and over the fee shall be \$1 per head.

- 2. The fee for each standpipe shall be \$100.
- 3. The fee for each independent pre-engineered suppression system shall be \$50.
- 4. The fee for each gas or oil-fired appliance which is not connected to the plumbing system shall be \$50 (R3-R% exempt) \$25.
- 5. The fee for each kitchen exhaust system shall be \$65. \$50.

- The fee for spray booths exhaust system shall be \$50.
- 7. The fee for a wood/coal burning stove, prefab or masonry fireplace shall be \$50. \$25.
- 8. The fee for smoke, heat detectors and manual fire alarms shall be \$60 for up to 20 alarms;

- 132. The fee for an annual permit shall be charged annually, and shall be a flat fee based on the number of maintenance workers excluding managers, engineers and clerks who are primarily engaged in work governed by a subcode (building/fire, electrical and plumbing).

Fees shall be as follows:

- (a) One through 25 workers (including foremen) \$400 per worker; each additional worker over 25 \$150 per worker.
- (b) Prior to the issuance of the annual permit a training registration fee of \$100 per subcode shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department of Community Affairs, Construction Code Element, Training Section along with a copy of the construction permit (Form F-170). Checks shall be made payable to "Treasurer, State of New Jersey."

- 1. No fees shall be charged for construction of any permitted building or structure owned by the County of Somerset or the Borough of Bernardsville or any of their respective agencies.
- Newly constructed and rehabilitated residential units that are to be legally restricted
 to occupancy by households of low and moderate income shall be exempt from
 construction permit fees, except for the State Training Fee.
- Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27D-126e, no person shall be charged a construction permit fee or enforcing agency fee for any construction, reconstruction, alteration or improvement designed and undertaken solely to promote accessibility by the handicapped to an existing public or private structure or any of the facilities contained therein.
- g. Outside Agency Fees. Notwithstanding any other fee hereinafter set forth, when the Borough has retained a private on-site inspection or plan review agency to carry out subcode official responsibility no fee charged shall exceed the amount paid by the Borough to that private agency plus 15%. Section 2. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 3. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
