

**BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 2017- 1749**

**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING PARKING RESTRICTIONS  
ON CLAREMONT ROAD AND AMENDING CHAPTER VII  
OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED “TRAFFIC”**

---

*Statement of Purpose: To impose additional parking restrictions on Claremont Road.*

---

**WHEREAS**, Police Chief Kevin Valentine and Public Works Manager John Macdowall met with representatives of Somerset County Traffic Engineering to discuss center line markings and parking regulations along Claremont Road (CR 525) between Route 202 and Olcott Lane/Mendham Road; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the results of that meeting, the County proposed a number of striping and no parking recommendations for the roadway, including the no parking restrictions set forth below;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, New Jersey, that Chapter VII of the Borough Code entitled “Traffic” is hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

**Section 1.** §7-7.6 entitled “Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets” is hereby supplemented and amended by adding the following new parking restrictions on Claremont Road:

**7-7.6 Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets.** No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any streets or parts of streets described.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
<u>Claremont Road</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>From its intersection with Essex Street in a southerly direction to 160 feet south of the extended southerly curb line of Essex Street.</u>

Claremont Road                      East                      From its intersection with Mill Street in a northerly direction to 193 feet south of the extended southerly curb line of Mine Mount.

Claremont Road                      East                      From its intersection with Orchard Hill Road/Thompson Street in a northerly direction to its intersection with Olcott Lane/Mendham Road.

**Section 2.** Since the subject portion of Claremont Road is a Somerset County road, this ordinance shall not take effect until Bernardsville Borough has obtained the consent of the Somerset County Board of Chosen Freeholders to these parking restrictions in accordance with the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.2*.

**Section 3.** The effectiveness of this ordinance is contingent upon signs being erected as required by law.

**Section 4.** Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

**Section 5.** In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 6.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
