

**BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2017-1753**

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE NUMBER OF PERMITTED BERNARDS HIGH SCHOOL PARKING SPACES IN LIBRARY LOT FROM 5 TO 15 AND AMENDING CHAPTER VIII OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "PARKING LOTS AND OFF-STREET TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, subsection 8-4A.2 of the Borough Code entitled "Employee, Client, Customer and Patron Spaces; Special Permits; Parking Restrictions" presently permits the Borough Council in its sole discretion to authorize the Somerset Hills Board of Education to issue parking decals to not more than five Bernards High School students to park their vehicles for more than four hours in parking spaces located on the north side of the driveway from Church Street; and

WHEREAS, the School District has informed the governing body that it is suffering from a shortage of parking spaces this semester and has asked that the number of permitted student parking spaces in the library parking lot be increased from 5 to 15;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that Chapter VIII of the Borough Code Entitled "Parking Lots and Off-Street Traffic Regulations" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph "c" of subsection 8-4A.2 entitled "Employee, Client, Customer and Patron Spaces; Special Permits; Parking Restrictions" is amended to read as follows:

" c. The 26 parking spaces designated by signs located to the north side of the driveway from Church Street are restricted to patrons of the Bernardsville Public Library and shall be subject to a four-hour time limit. The Borough Council, in its sole discretion, from time to time, may also authorize the Somerset Hills Board of Education to issue parking decals to not more than five (5) fifteen (15) Bernards High School students to park their vehicles for more than four (4) hours in these parking spaces. These parking decals shall be non-transferable and must be affixed to the left rear bumper of the vehicle in accordance with instructions given by the Police Department to the administration of the high school. "

Section 2. In all other respects, subsection 8-4A.2 shall remain unchanged.

Section 3. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 4. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
