### BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE # 2018-1783

# AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING USES PERMITTED IN THE I INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AND AMENDING CHAPTER XII OF THE BOROUGH LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE ENTITLED "ZONING"

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To set forth the uses permitted in the I Industrial District, which is comprised of block 100, lots 2.23-2.49, and block 145, lots 1 & 2, all of which are commonly referred to collectively as the "Quarry". In particular, the purpose of this ordinance is to confirm the removal of materials recycling facilities and the recycling of trees and tree parts as permitted uses in the Quarry, to reinstate the recycling of concrete and soil as permitted uses in the Quarry, and to readopt the accessory uses provision. The end result will be that the uses permitted in the Quarry will be the same as they were at the time of the adoption of Ordinance #95-1030 and before the adoption of Ordinances 2013-1627 and 2015-1699.

WHEREAS, lots 2 and 2.23-2.49 in block 100 and lots 1 and 2 in block 145, commonly known as the Quarry (hereinafter referred to as the "Quarry"), comprise the I Industrial District; and

WHEREAS, the primary uses permitted in the Quarry were first set forth in Ordinance #95-1030, and were codified as subsection 12-18.1 in the Borough Land Development Code; and WHEREAS, subsection 12-18.1 was thereafter amended by the adoption of Ordinance #2013-1627, which added the recycling of trees and tree parts as permitted uses in the zone; and WHEREAS, subsection 12-18.1 was further amended by the adoption of Ordinance #2015-1699, which added materials recovery facilities as permitted uses in the zone; and WHEREAS, subsection 12-18.1 was further amended by the adoption of Ordinance #2018-1799, which, *inter alia*, removed materials recovery facilities and the recycling of concrete, trees, tree parts and soil as permitted uses in the zone; and

WHEREAS, the governing body wishes to confirm the removal of materials recovery facilities and the recycling of trees and tree parts as uses permitted in the zone, but to reinstate

the recycling of concrete and soil as permitted uses in the zone, and to readopt paragraph "k" dealing with accessory uses;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that Chapter XII of the Borough Land Use Code Entitled "Zoning" is hereby amended as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 12-18.1 entitled "Primary Intended Use [in the I Industrial District]" is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

#### "12-18 I INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT.

### 12-18.1 Primary Intended Use.

In the Industrial District a building may be erected or used and a lot may be used or occupied for any of the following purposes and uses and no other:

- a. The processing of stone, trees, tree parts, or rock products. Processing shall include grinding, polishing, coloring and otherwise treating the raw materials, as well as, the further use of such products in the manufacture of derivative or secondary products which are substantially different in form or character from the original raw materials.
- b. Bulk storage, wholesale and warehousing. (1) Wholesale establishments including, but not limited to, lumber and building materials sales, machinery sales and service, contractors' heavy equipment sales, rental and service and nursery and landscaping sales; (2) the storage of building material, trees, tree parts and bulk materials; (3) the parking or storage of vehicles or the maintenance or repair of commercial and industrial vehicles or equipment; and (4) parcel delivery and service distribution facilities.
- c. Shops such as construction and industrial trade shops, boat works (custom building and repair), ornamental iron workshops and monument works.
  - d. The manufacture or assembly of small parts and equipment.
  - e. Public utilities and facilities.
  - f. Self-storage facilities.

- g. Fuel oil storage and distribution.
- h. Recycling facility for the recycling of <u>concrete</u>, trees, tree parts, asphalt and soil.
- i. Retail sales shall be allowed as an accessory use incidental and subordinate to uses permitted in this zone. Areas devoted to retail sales shall be limited to one thousand (1,000) square feet.
- j. Materials recovery facility shall be subject to the following:
- 1. Materials to be recovered and recycled are limited to construction, demolition, and bulky solid waste, and
- 2. Demonstration that the applicant-user can comply with all Somerset County and State Department of Environmental Protection rules and regulations, including, but not limited to, N.J.A.C. 7:26-2.1 et seq; and
- 3. Capacity of facility is less than one hundred (100) tons per day; and
- 4. All construction, demolition and bulky solid waste materials shall be delivered, separated and processed within an enclosed building.
- \_j.k. Other accessory uses on the same lot and customarily incidental to the principal use, such as office and shipping facilities, machine shop, locker room, boiler room, scale house, concrete plant, asphalt plant and rock crushers.
- **Section 2.** Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.
- **Section 3.** In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

### BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2018-1784

# AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DOGS AND OTHER PETS ON ALL CERTAIN BOROUGH ATHLETIC FIELDS AND SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING CHAPTER V OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "ANIMAL CONTROL"

**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:** To prohibit dogs and all other pets on all certain Borough athletic fields.

WHEREAS, dogs and other pets can damage natural grass athletic fields, as well as the new turf fields at the upper polo grounds; and

WHEREAS, the governing body wishes to preserve and maintain those athletic fields for their intended use by teams and individuals; and

WHEREAS, subsection 5-9.1 of the Borough Code already prohibits dogs in certain parks during certain time period;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the governing body of the Borough of Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that Chapter V of the Borough Code Entitled "Animal Control" is supplemented and amended as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby added a new section 5-10 entitled "DOGS AND OTHER PETS PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON ALL CERTAIN BOROUGH ATHLETIC FIELDS".

5-10.1 Dogs and Other Pets Prohibited on All <u>Certain</u> Borough Athletic Fields at All Times.

No dogs or other domestic animals (with the exception of service animals), whether leashed or unleashed, attended or unattended, shall be permitted on the playing surface of <u>the following</u> athletic fields owned by the Borough of Bernardsville:

Kiwanis Baseball Fields (2) (Block 35, Lot 2) Rosebowl Field (Block 97, Lot 1)

### Claremont Field (Block 69, Lots 8, 9 and 29) Polo Grounds Turf Field (Block 35, Lot 2)

This ordinance does not apply to areas other than the playing surface of athletic fields, such as surrounding spectator areas, and/or playgrounds.

#### 5-10.2 Definitions.

For purpose of this Ordinance, "service animal" shall mean any dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability. Other species of animals, whether wild or domestic, trained or untrained, are not service animals for the purposes of this definition. The work or tasks performed by a service animal must be directly related to the individual's disability. Examples of work or tasks include, but are not limited to, assisting individuals who are blind or have low vision with navigation and other tasks, alerting individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing to the presence of people or sounds, providing non-violent protection or rescue work, pulling a wheelchair, assisting an individual during a seizure, alerting individuals to the presence of allergens, retrieving items such as medicine or the telephone, providing physical support and assistance with balance and stability to individuals with mobility disabilities, and helping persons with psychiatric and neurological disabilities by preventing or interrupting impulsive or destructive behaviors. The crime deterrent effects of an animal's presence and the provision of emotional support, well-being, comfort, or companionship do not constitute work or tasks for the purposes of this definition.

#### 5-10.3 Signs.

All of the Borough athletic fields covered by this ordinance shall be clearly posted as "No Pet" zones.

#### 5-10.4 Penalties.

Any person who violates this section shall, upon conviction, be subject to the penalties set forth in section 1-5 of this Code.

**Section 2.** Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

**Section 3.** In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

### APPROPRIATING \$950,000 FROM THE BOROUGH OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF 251 CLAREMONT ROAD

**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:** To appropriate \$950,000 from the Borough open space trust fund to purchase 251 Claremont Road to provide access to the Peters Tract which has been underutilized because of limited parking and access

WHEREAS, the Peters Tract, a 30.35-acre parcel located at 277 Claremont Road (block 17, lot 30) which is owned by the Borough and which is on the Borough's Recreation and Open Space Inventory ("ROSI") has been underutilized for recreation and open space purposes because of a lack of adequate parking and access; and

WHEREAS, property located at 251 Claremont Road and known as block 17, lot 28 on the Borough Tax Maps is currently on the market; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is interested in purchasing this property using a combination of Green Acres funds and Borough Open Space Trust Funds because it is adjacent to the Peters Tract and could be used to provide parking and access to the Peters Tract; and

WHEREAS, any monies received from Green Acres would be used to replenish the Borough Open Space Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is in the process of obtaining two appraisals of the property;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of
Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

**Section 1.** \$950,000 is hereby appropriated from the Borough Open Space Trust Fund to purchase the property described in the preamble, to be used for open space and recreation purposes and, in particular, to provide parking and access to the Peters Tract.

**Section 2.** Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

**Section 3.** In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

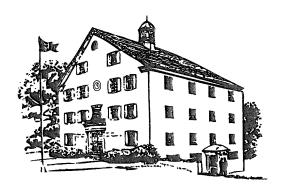

# RESOLUTION #18-252 ESTABLISHING DECAL FEES AND OTHER REGULATIONS FOR MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS DURING 2019

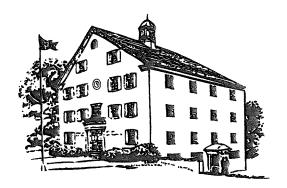
**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough Council, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter VIII, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bernardsville, as follows:

- 1. The 2019 fees shall be as follows:

  - F. Decals issued after June 30 shall be one-half the annual fee
  - G. Decals issued after Oct 1 shall be one-quarter the annual fee
- 2. A maximum of 200 decals will be issued for the RAILROAD PLAZA PARKING LOT.
  - A. 70 decals will be offered to commuters without regard to residency.
  - B. 130 decals shall be limited to commuters who are residents of the Borough of Bernardsville.
  - C. After March 1<sup>st</sup>, decals will be sold on demand.
- 3. A maximum of 130 decals will be issued for the MOUNT AIRY PARKING LOT.
  - A. 59 decals shall be sold to merchants for their employees to satisfy off-site parking requirements, as dictated by Planning Board resolutions.
  - B. 71 decals will be offered to merchants for use by their employees.
- 4. Applicants for decals for the Railroad Plaza and Mount Airy lots must present vehicle registration. If a resident's registration does not show a Bernardsville address, call 766-3000 ext. 110 or 123 for instructions.
- 5. Parking decals must be affixed to the left rear bumper of the vehicle, in accordance with instructions provided by the Borough Clerk, and "regulations" for use of the parking lots pursuant to local ordinance must be observed.

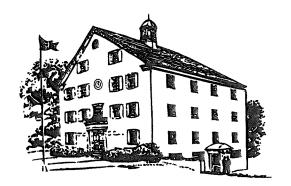

# RESOLUTION ACCEPTING SOMERSET COUNTY'S PROPOSAL TO INSTALL PADDING ON THE FENCING AT THE NEW TURF FIELD LOCATED AT THE POLO GROUNDS

WHEREAS, County Engineer Matthew D. Loper, P.E., in a September 28, 2018 email to Assistant Borough Administrator Doug Walker, said that ASTM STP 1073, Natural and Artificial Playing Fields: Characteristics and Safety Features' provides the following safety guidance on playing fields and specifically fence placement:

'The furthest game line of the end zone shall be no closer than 9.1 m (30 feet) or if a closer dimension is required, a padded fence or wall shall be installed."; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Loper went on to say that:

"As recommended by ASTM STP 1073, we recommend that the fence remain at its current location and installing chain link fence padding. . . . If acceptable by the Borough, the County will pay for 100% of the cost of installing the fence padding. Future maintenance of this padding will be the responsibility of the Borough. . . .";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Bernardsville, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that it does hereby accept the County's proposal to install chain link fence padding on the fence at the new turf field at the Polo Grounds in accordance with ASTM STP 1073.
