ORDINANCE #2023-1971

BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO MUNICIPAL PROPERTY IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF BERNARDSVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$1,700,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,615,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH FOR FINANCING SUCH APPROPRIATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BERNARDSVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), **AS FOLLOWS**:

Section 1. The improvement described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance is hereby authorized as a general improvement to be made or acquired by the Borough of Bernardsville, New Jersey. For the said improvement or purpose stated in said Section 3, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,700,000, said sum being inclusive of all appropriations heretofore made therefor and including the sum of \$85,000 as the down payment for said improvement or purpose required by law and now available therefor in the Open Space Trust Fund of the Borough for down payment or for capital improvement purposes.

Section 2. For the financing of said improvement or purpose and to meet the part of said \$1,700,000 appropriation not provided for by application hereunder of said down payment, negotiable bonds of the Borough are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$1,615,000 pursuant to the Local Bond Law of New Jersey. In anticipation of the issuance of said bonds and to temporarily finance said improvement or purpose, negotiable notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$1,615,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 3. (a) The improvement hereby authorized and purpose for the financing of which said obligations are to be issued is the improvement of municipally-owned property in and by the Borough in accordance with the open space and recreation master plan, including, but not limited to, the removal of the dam at Nervine Park in order to restore the waterway and improve water quality, together with all grading, channel restoration landscaping, engineering, equipment, structures, site work, work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto, all in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor on file or to be filed in the office of the Borough Clerk and hereby approved.

(b) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued for said purpose is \$1,615,000.

(c) The estimated cost of said purpose is \$1,700,000, the excess thereof over the said estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued therefor being the amount of the said \$85,000 down payment for said purpose.

Section 4. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

(a) The said purpose described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance is not a current expense and is a property or improvement which the Borough may lawfully acquire or make as a general improvement, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.

(b) The period of usefulness of said purpose within the limitations of said Local Bond Law, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the said bonds authorized by this bond ordinance, is fifteen (15) years.

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(c) The supplemental debt statement required by said Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey, and such statement shows that the gross debt of the Borough as defined in said Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided for in this bond ordinance by \$1,615,000, and the said obligations authorized by this bond ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

(d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$170,000 for interest on said obligations, costs of issuing said obligations and other items of expense listed in and permitted under section 40A:2-20 of said Local Bond Law may be included as part of the cost of said improvement and is included in the foregoing estimate thereof.

Section 5. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer, provided that no note shall mature later than one year from its date. The notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer. The Chief Financial Officer shall determine all matters in connection with the notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the Chief Financial Officer's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. §40A:2-8. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time at public or private sale at not loss than par and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the dates of delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to report in

writing to the governing body of the Borough at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include the principal amount, interest rate and maturities of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 6. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the said obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Borough for the payment of said obligations and interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

Section 7. The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Borough Clerk and are available for public inspection.

Section 8. This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by said Local Bond Law.

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2023, at a duly noticed and constituted public meeting, the Borough Council of the Borough of Bernardsville (the "Borough Council") introduced, on first reading, proposed Ordinance No. 2023-1974 (the "Proposed Ordinance"), which would allow non-family members to occupy detached accessory dwelling units in the R-1 and R-1-10 zones; and

WHEREAS, after introduction, the Borough Council referred the Proposed Ordinance to the Planning Board of the Borough of Bernardsville (the "Board") for Master Plan consistency review, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26(a) and N.J.S.A. 40:55D-64; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2023, at a duly noticed and constituted public meeting, the Board considered the testimony of the Board Planner and any comments from members of the public and determined that the Proposed Ordinance is not inconsistent with the Borough's Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full;

Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines that Ordinance No. 2023-1974, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, is not inconsistent with the Borough's Master Plan and recommends that the Borough Council consider, from a policy perspective, whether it desires to continue treating detached accessory dwelling units as conditional uses, which requires Planning Board application even for fully conforming conditional uses, or alternatively to designate same as permitted accessory uses, which would only require a land use board application in the event of some other relief being necessitated by the development project;

Section 3. The Recording Secretary of the Board shall forward a copy of this Resolution with the attached Ordinance to the Borough Council. This Resolution shall serve as the report to the governing body in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26(a) and N.J.S.A. 40:55D-64; and

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE #2023-1974

ALLOWING NON-FAMILY MEMBERS TO OCCUPY DETACHED ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS IN THE R-1 AND R-1-10 ZONES

WHEREAS, detached accessory dwelling units are permitted as conditional uses in the

R-1 and R-1-10 zones pursuant to § LD12-25; and

WHEREAS, paragraph "m" of § LD12-25.2 limits the occupancy of detached accessory

dwelling units to on-site domestic employees, members of the immediate family or non-paying

short-term guests of the residents of the principal residence; and

WHEREAS, the Housing/Property Maintenance/Zoning Compliance Advisory

Committee has recommended that those restrictions be removed; and

WHEREAS, the governing body agrees with the recommendation of the

Housing/Property Maintenance/Zoning Compliance Advisory Committee;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of

Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that subparagraphs 3, 8 and 9 in

paragraph "m" of § LD-12-25.2 entitled "Conditional Uses Permitted" is amended as follows:

"m. Accessory Dwelling Unit, Detached,.... The following conditions shall be met:

3. The detached accessory dwelling unit shall be for the sole use of the on-site domestic employees, members of the immediate family or non-paying short-term guest of the resident of the principal residence except, when the owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program. In any event, the The detached accessory dwelling unit shall not be occupied by more than four persons.

8. The applicant shall submit at the time of seeking conditional use approval, and annually thereafter, a certification on forms provided by the Borough, as follows:

(a) That the detached accessory dwelling unit is occupied by on-site domestic employees of the residents of the principal residence or by members of the immediate family or short-term, nonpaying guest of the residents of the principal residence, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program. In any event, the detached accessory dwelling unit shall be occupied by no more than four persons.

(b) That the detached accessory dwelling unit is not a rental unit and no rent is paid on account of the occupancy of the accessory apartment, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program.

(c) That the living area of the detached dwelling unit is not a rental unit and no rent is paid on account of the occupancy of the accessory apartment, except when the Owner is approved to rent units under the Borough's Accessory Apartment Program.

(d) That upon any violation of this section or the certification, determined by the appropriate Borough official, the violation shall be abated and the owner shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Article 16 of this Code.

9. Prior to issuance of a building permit for the detached accessory dwelling unit, a new deed shall be recorded in the Somerset County Clerk's Office containing a restriction stating that the detached accessory dwelling unit must be used in strict compliance with this section.

Section 2. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any

of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 3. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid

in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or

provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid

shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE #2023-1975

CONCERNING OUTDOOR DINING AND AMENDING ARTICLE 12 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "ZONING"

WHEREAS, the Housing, Property Maintenance and Zoning Compliance Advisory

Committee has recommended that certain administrative requirements be added to the outdoor

dining ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of

Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Land

Development Regulations are hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

Section 2. Section LD-12-12.9 entitled "Outdoor Dining" is hereby supplemented and

amended by adding new paragraphs "h" through "l", as follows:

"§ LD-12-12.9 Outdoor Dining.

Outdoor Dining shall be permitted within the Downtown District as accessory to an existing indoor restaurant only subject to the following regulations:

- a. No outdoor table, shelf or other facility to hold food or drink while the same are being consumed shall be permitted in any nonresidential zone except in accordance with this subsection.
- b. The dining area must be on private property. If any portion of the dining area is on a sidewalk over which the public has a right-of-way, an unobstructed passage not less than four feet wide must be left between the dining area and any street, structure, hydrant, lamppost, highway signpost or other obstruction. No portion of the dining area may be closer than four feet to any fire lane, parking lot or loading dock. No portion of any required parking space or loading dock shall be converted to dining area, except that temporary outdoor dining facilities may be permitted in required parking space or loading dock areas if the Borough Zoning Officer determines that such temporary outdoor dining would not adversely impact pedestrian or vehicular traffic, result in insufficient parking for the restaurant and neighboring uses, or otherwise be a danger to public safety.
- c. The dining area shall be surrounded by a defining barrier not less than two feet high such as landscaping, a fence or ropes and posts. If any portion of the dining area is within 10 feet of any area used by vehicles and less than two feet above such area, the barrier shall be designed to protect the dining area unless the same is protected by trees or other means. Any immovable portion of the barrier, or any permanent roof, arbor,

platform or similar structure shall be considered a site improvement for the purpose of § 12-12.4, Administrative Procedures, requiring site plans proposing site improvements to be drawn by a licensed person. The placement of tables and chairs in the dining area and the provision of passages through the barrier shall not obstruct entry to or exit from any building. Folding chairs are prohibited. No advertising or product names are permitted on any tablecloths, chairs or umbrellas in the dining area.

- d. No use of the dining area shall be permitted after 10:00 p.m. or before 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Wednesday. Outdoor dining shall not be permitted after 11:59 p.m. or before 6:00 a.m. Thursday through Saturday.
- e. Convenient containers for trash and recyclables shall be provided. The operator of the dining area shall keep it clean, sanitary and free from litter.
- f. With the permission of the Board of Health and/or the Fire Department as to the maximum number of people in the indoor and outdoor spaces, the restaurant may serve indoor and outdoor diners simultaneously.
- g. <u>Restaurants having outdoor dining facilities must keep all outdoor equipment and</u> <u>furnishings in good condition and repair. Tables, chairs, umbrellas, awnings and other</u> <u>furniture used in the outdoor facilities must be kept free of rips, tears and broken</u> <u>components. Broken items shall be removed from outdoor areas promptly. All outdoor</u> <u>items including the tops of umbrellas and awnings should be kept in a clean and</u> <u>sanitary condition.</u>
- h. Outdoor chairs and tables for each establishment shall be of a uniform style. Cloth items, including awnings and umbrellas shall be of a uniform color scheme and materials. Colors shall be earth tones from white through natural "red."
- i. All outdoor furnishings and equipment shall be removed from pedestrian routes from December 1 through March 31 to facilitate removal of ice and snow. During such period, outdoor furnishings should be stored so that they are not visible from the street and neighboring lots.
- j. By March 30th of each year establishments providing outdoor dining must deliver a written outdoor dining plan to the Zoning Officer and a fee of \$100.¹ The plan shall include the following information and such other additional information, if any, as may be requested by the Zoning Officer as she or he deems necessary to determine compliance with the Borough's ordinances:

i. A description of the proposed design and location of the outdoor dining or outdoor seating, its dimensions and all temporary structures, equipment, and apparatus to be used in connection with its operation, including tables, temporary fences and barriers, planters, service carts, chairs, awning, umbrellas (including any name to be displayed thereon), lighting and electrical outlets (if any) and a diagram of the above items; and

ii. A statement of the seating capacity of the proposed outdoor dining or outdoor seating and of the existing restaurant or service business actually operated by the applicant in the principal building.

- <u>k.</u> The Zoning Officer, after reviewing this submission, shall recommend approval, disapproval, or modification of the plan within 10 business days following its submission. The Zoning Officer shall refer the plan to the Fire Chief, the Chief of Police, the Construction Official, the Fire Marshall, the Board of Health, the Borough Engineer and/or the Borough Planner for their review and recommendations.
- <u>1.</u> Failure to comply with the approved plan will subject the restaurant to the penalties set forth in Section 1-5 of this Code."

Section 2. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with

any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or

inconsistent.

Section 3. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held

invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section

or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared

invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

BERNARDSVILLE BOROUGH ORDINANCE #2023-1976

PROHIBITING DRIVE-THROUGHS IN THE DOWNTOWN ZONE DISTRICT AND SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING ARTICLE 12 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "ZONING"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to prohibit drive-through facilities in all

downtown zone districts

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of

Bernardsville in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that § LD-12-12 entitled

"Downtown District" in the Borough Land Development Regulations is hereby supplemented

and amended as follows:

Section 1. § LD-12-12.6 entitled, "Permitted Uses in the Downtown District and All

Subdistricts" is amended by deleting paragraph "n" as follows:

§ LD-12-12.6 Permitted Uses in the Downtown District and All Subdistricts.

Unless specifically prohibited within a subdistrict or elsewhere in this section, the following uses are permitted in the Downtown District:

n. Drive-through facilities shall be allowed for pharmacies only.

Section 2. § LD-12-12.10 entitled, "Specifically Prohibited Uses" is supplemented and

amended by adding a new paragraph "t" which reads as follows:

§ LD-12-12.10 Prohibited Uses.

In addition to the uses prohibited in § 12-23.16, any use not specifically enumerated as expressly permitted herein is hereby prohibited including the following specific uses in all subdistricts unless otherwise indicated:

t. Drive-through facilities.

Section 3. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.

Section 4. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
