QUESTIONS FOR THE RECREATION DIRECTOR/CORRESPONDENCE:

Cheryl Ferrante reported on the Directors Report about recreation programs and the pool. The new youth soccer program began on September 13th for grades K-3rd with 70 children participating. Fall enrichment programs begin the first week of October with Motorized Legos, NASA with Mad Science, Junior Engineering and Hot Shot Tennis being run. There is an average of 12 students enrolled per program. The Fishing Derby will be held on Saturday, October 13th with over 65 participants registered. Travel Basketball has tryouts beginning on October 16th with 10 team participating. The Senior Holiday Luncheon, which is co-sponsored by the Lions Club will be held on Saturday, December 1st. Dates are being finalized for the high school and middle school ski trips. The high school ski trip will go to Camelback and the middle school ski trip will go to Shawnee. The wrestling program for grades K-8 is accepting registrations for the 2018-2019 season. A shade structure has been installed in between the training pool and baby pool. The pool complex will be winterized.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Andrew Taylor reported on the financial report that the pool is up \$4,000 and rec programs are up \$11,000 from 2017. Programs in the trust fund are also up \$25,000 from 2017.
